(It the time of your procedure changes, you must still begin your 2nd dose of prep solution) 4 hours before the time of your procedure and fully consume it within 1 hour).

- 1. Drink 16oz. of Miralax mixture from above
- 2. Drink an additional 16oz of Gatorade or another hydration drink
- 3. Follow with 2 (two) Gas-X tablets

(Consume the above bowel prep within 1 hour)

** It is very important that you DO NOT drink ANYTHING 3 hours prior to your arrival time. **

This entire process is required and is important to follow to ensure a clean colon. If not, your physician will not be able to complete as thorough an exam and you may be asked to repeat your procedure.
